IDS Schooling Show COVID-19 Protocol

We value every person who will be on the showgrounds. To keep everyone safe, we are following <u>USEF COVID-19 Guidelines</u>. As an overview, please follow these guidelines:

- 1. If you have tested positive for COVID-19, know you have been exposed to someone who has, or exhibit any signs of illness in the past 14 days, please do not compete or volunteer at this show.
- 2. If you become ill while on the grounds, or test positive for COVID-19 within 14 days after the show, please notify the show manager or show volunteer coordinator.
- 3. Medical personnel will use a touchless thermometer to take the temperatures of all judges, volunteers, and office staff upon entering the show grounds. Anyone with a temperature of 99.5°F will not be permitted.
- 4. Everyone on showgrounds is required to wear a facemask in any setting where there is a possibility of being within six feet of anyone from another household. Please bring a facemask you'll be comfortable wearing throughout the day. Riders are exempt when mounted on a horse.
- 5. All individuals should practice social distancing while on the showgrounds by staying at least 6 feet from any person who is not a member of their immediate household.
- 6. Wash hands often and adhere to other sanitization practices throughout the day.
- 7. Spectators are prohibited from the showgrounds. An entrant is permitted a maximum of three support people such as a parent, coach, and/or groom.
