COVID-19 Best Practices

Please read the attached document regarding best practices that will be in place this weekend. The health and safety of our competitors, volunteers, and horse show staff is priority #1.

Show Office Access

The show office will be limited to the show staff. We will be distributing rider packets and ribbons under the pavilion. If you need to speak to a member of the staff, please knock on the window and we will be able to assist you.

Saturday Arrival and Schooling Times

Horse stalls will be labeled and unlocked by 10am on Saturday. Once you unload your horses, please pickup your show packet under the large Dressage Complex pavilion to retrieve your horse's bridle tag. Your horse should wear the bridle tag at all times outside of the stabling area.

The entire Dressage Complex will be available for schooling Saturday from 10:30am until dusk. Feel free to ride anywhere in the competition and schooling arenas in the Dressage Complex.

Shavings

Shavings pre-ordered with your entry will be stocked in your stall when you arrive. The Stall Chart lists the number of shavings bags as confirmation of your order.

Shavings will also be available for sale by the Hoosier Horse Park office on Saturday until approximately 2pm. Please have cash - I don't believe they can take credit cards. After that, come to the Dressage Office as we will have a limited supply of shavings for sale.

Camping

Campsites located between Barn K and Barn L can be rented by calling the Hoosier Horse Park at 812-526-6809. Each campsite includes 30A electric and water hookups.

Black Horse One Electronic Tests

We have decided to use electronic scribing in lieu of paper tests in an effort to reduce as much chance of contamination as possible. This is a big change for us. We'll be using software from Black Horse One that runs the biggest International- and National-level Dressage competitions worldwide.

You'll soon receive an invitation email from Black Horse One to establish your account. A tutorial on the process is attached to this email. You will be able to view your test score and comments from your smartphone as soon as your class is complete. We will still post the scores on the board near the Dressage office and distribute ribbons under the pavilion.

Ring Sizes

By default classes will be held in 20m x 60m rings with the exception of the following morning classes in Ring 2 which will be configured as 20m x 40m until lunchtime:

- Class 01: USDF Introductory Test A
- Class 02: USDF Introductory Test B
- Class 18: USEF Eventing Test of Choice
- Class 19: USPC / 4-H Test of Choice
- Class 20: USPC / 4-H Test of Choice
- Class 23: WDAA Intro Test of Choice
- Class 24: WDAA Basic Test of Choice

Smokehouse BBQ Food Truck
