**Opening Date:** Tuesday July 6, 2021    **Closing Date:** Wednesday August 11, 2021

**Awards:** Ribbons awarded to 6<sup>th</sup> place in each class/division.

**Prize List:** Prize lists will be sent to each current member of the IDS and ADA 30 days prior to the competition's date and a minimum of 2 weeks prior to the closing date for entries. Lists will be sent either by direct mail or via email.

**Classes:** Current USDF/USEF/WDAA tests will be used.

**Rule Adherence:** Members of IDS, ADA, and any other attending exhibitors are responsible for knowledge of and adherence to all rules that govern competitors at IDS and ADA approved competitions.

**Entries:** Entries and payment should be mailed to the show secretary with checks payable to Shrine Charity Horse Show. Complete entries must be received by the closing date. Entries will be accepted in the order received until the show is full, then entries are placed on a waitlist. Show committee reserves the right to limit entries, limit the classes per horse, to add, divide, combine or cancel classes where appropriate. Each entry must be signed by the rider and the parent if necessary. It must also include proof of a negative coggins within 12 months of show date. Name on the Coggins must match the name of the horse on the entry form. **Post Entries** will be accepted, at the discretion of the show committee, for an additional fee of \$15.

**Refunds** Exhibitor withdrawal for any reason prior to the closing date will be refunded minus the office fee. Waitlisted entries will receive a full refund if not accepted. Cancellations must be made *in writing* to the show secretary. Email is acceptable. No refunds after the closing date.

**Confirmation & Ride Times:** Ride times will be emailed to each exhibitor three days prior to the show date. They will also be posted on Facebook under Shrine Horse Show Columbia City, on the alldressageassociation.com site, and on the indianadressage.org site. Please include a **legible** email address for ride times to be sent to. Ride times may change, check the daysheets for confirmed times.

**Dressage Show Schedule and Ride Time Conflicts** It is the responsibility of the rider to inform the management of any time conflicts as soon as possible after receiving the schedule. Changes need to be requested in writing in the show office by 3pm on the day prior to your class. Day of changes will be honored to the extent possible.

**No Shows** All "no shows" that have not contacted the show office, in writing, will be considered a scratch for the rest of the show and their time slots may be filled by other exhibitors. No refunds will be given. Exhibitors entering the show do so with this understanding and agreement.

**Attire:** ASTM/SEI helmets with fastened chin straps must be worn at all times when mounted.

Show attire is not required. Helmet, boots, breeches and schooling attire are permitted.

**Dressage Bridle Numbers:** Bridle numbers must be worn at any time the horse is out of its stall.

**Scores and Test Sheet Pick Up:** You should be able to check your score within 45-60 minutes of your ride. Test sheets are usually available for pickup after the class results and placings are posted. **No** tests can be returned until the entire class is completed, scored, and results posted.

**Please do not disturb** the scorers or secretary by requesting your score or test sheet before the class is finished.

**Classes/Arena:** Current USDF/USEF/FEI/WDAA tests will be used. Classes will run in a 20 x 60 ring unless stated otherwise. Footing in the competition ring a mixture of sifted soils and sand. The warm up and lunging areas are grass. For safety reasons, exhibitors are reminded not to lunge horses in any areas other than the lunging area.

**Closed Rings:** The Competition Ring will be closed to riders. Horses and handlers are not permitted in arenas when equipment is being used or a course is being set for an upcoming class. The equipment operators will try to verbally warn exhibitors of upcoming grooming or arena changes. However, if exhibitors see equipment sitting next to an arena waiting to work within it, they are required to leave the arena for their own and their riders' safety. Violation of the above **MAY** be considered cause for elimination from the show.

**Stabling:** \$50 permanent stalls on the grounds are available from August 20 through the end of the show. One bag of shavings is included with each stall. Additional bedding is available for purchase, \$7./bag All reservations are taken on a first come first served basis. Stalls must be ordered with the Stall Reservation section on your dressage entry form. They may also be recorded through a Text Message, not a call, to Justin Smith 260-705-4708 No stalls will be reserved until payment has been received. You may, or course, include your stall payment with your class entry monies or pay Justin when you arrive.

**Campers** Campers may be dropped off after 2 pm Thursday August 19, 2021. Electric Hookups will not be available until Friday August 20. Campsites include 30A and 50A hookups; please make sure you bring the correct plug size/type and an extension cord rated for your usage level. Campers hooked up to electricity will be charged \$25.00 for the weekend of August 20-22, 2021. Payment must be received prior to electrical hookup. Contact is Justin Smith 260-705-4708. Payment may be given to Justin.

**Facilities:** Restrooms and on-site concessions available.

**Departure:** All horses and trailers shall leave the Shrine grounds no later than 7 pm Sunday August 22, 2021

**Liability Releases:** No numbers or ride times will be released until all liability forms, both those of the sanctioning body and the show grounds, are signed. Photography releases must also be signed and returned to the Show Secretary.
