Awards: Ribbons awarded to 6th place in each class/division. Championship classes will receive 1st and 2nd place neck ribbons at the Ride Offs with additional awards and ribbons to 6th place awarded later.

On-line Entries via Equestrian Entries at https://equestrianentries.com/ are prefered.

Mail Entries: Entry form and Coggins should be mailed to show secretary with checks payable to *Indiana Dressage Society*.

Coggins: Negative Coggins required for all horses within 12 months of show date. Name on Coggins must match the name of the horse on the entry form.

Complete entries must be received by the closing date. Each entry must be signed by the rider, owner of horse, trainer and parent if applicable. Entries will be accepted in the order received until the show is full, then entries are added to the waitlist. Failure to submit a complete entry may result in being placed on the waitlist. IDS Members will have priority on the waitlist.

Confirmation & Ride Times: Will be available on https://www.indianadressage.org/ three days prior to show date. Times will be tentative and may change. Check the Day Sheet posted at the show for confirmed ride times.

Concessions: To be determined. The first 30 complete entries will receive a FREE Breakfast Voucher worth \$10!

Attire: Formal show attire and required for Championship classes and optional in non-Championship classes. *ASTM approved helmets with fastened chinstrap must be worn by all riders at all times.*

COVID Action Plan: This competition will follow the <u>USEF COVID-19 Action Plan</u>. Masks are required for any person who is not fully vaccinated for COVID.

Dogs: Dogs must be leashed at all times while on the show grounds.

Non-Compete Horses: Non-compete horses must have a valid entry, Coggins, and pay Office Fee plus either Stabling or Haul-in Fee.

Camping: Campsites include 30A electric and water may be reserved on the entry form.

Bedding: Bedding can be ordered with your entry for \$8/bag. Bags will be in your stall when you arrive.

Stall Stripping: The Hoosier Horse Park requires you strip your horse's stall and pile used bedding 1' outside the stall door upon departure. You may pay the optional \$40 stall stripping fee if you'd like to have your stall stripped by IDS after the show.

Refunds: Full refund minus office fee prior to closing date. Waitlist Entries: full refund if not accepted.

Classes: Current USDF/USEF/FEI/WDAA tests will be used. Classes will be run in 20m x 60m rings unless stated otherwise. The show will be conducted under USEF rules unless otherwise noted by show management. Show management reserves the right to limit entries, limit the classes per horse, to add, divide, combine or cancel classes or make whatever changes required by circumstances of the competition.

Non-Championship Classes: All classes numbered below #500 are Non-Championship classes that do not require prior qualification. Scores from Non-Championship classes count towards the 2022 IDS competition season.

Championship Classes: Classes numbered #500 and above are the 2021 IDS Championship classes. All entrants must be qualified per the rules of the IDS Year End Awards Program. Scores from Championship classes do not count toward the 2022 Awards Program.

The horse owner and rider must be current IDS members when scores are earned in order to be eligible for the IDS Awards program. In 2021, the IDS Board of Directors voted to approve a Retroactive Score Fee which can be submitted to allow horse owners and/or riders to unlock scores earned during a period where membership was not current.
