**Awards:** Ribbons awarded to 6th place in each class/division.

**On-line Entries** via Equestrian Entries at <https://equestrianentries.com/> are preferred.

**Mail Entries:** Entry form and Coggins should be mailed to show secretary with checks payable to *Indiana Dressage Society*.

**Coggins:** Negative Coggins required for all horses within 12 months of show date. Name on Coggins must match the name of the horse on the entry form.

**Complete entries must be received by the closing date.** Each entry must be signed by the rider, owner of horse, trainer and parent if applicable. Entries will be accepted in the order received until the show is full, then entries are added to the waitlist. Failure to submit a complete entry may result in being placed on the waitlist. IDS Members will have priority on the waitlist.

**Confirmation & Ride Times:** Will be available on <https://www.indianadressage.org/> three days prior to show date. Times will be *tentative* and may change. Check the Day Sheet posted at the show for *confirmed* ride times.

**Concessions:** [Serendipity Mobile Catering](#) will be on-site for breakfast and lunch. The first 30 complete entries will receive a FREE Food Truck Voucher worth \$10!

**Attire:** Formal show attire is optional in all classes. *ASTM approved helmets with fastened chinstrap must be worn by all riders at all times.*

**Non-Compete Horses:** Non-competer horses must have a valid entry, Coggins, and pay Office Fee plus either Stabling or Haul-in Fee.

**Camping:** Campsites include 30A electric and water may be reserved on the entry form.

**Bedding:** Bedding can be ordered with your entry for \$9/bag. Bags will be in your stall when you arrive.

**Stall Stripping:** The Hoosier Horse Park requires you strip your horse's stall and pile used bedding 1' outside the stall door upon departure. You may pay the optional \$30 stall stripping fee if you'd like to have your stall stripped by IDS after the show.

**Refunds:** Full refund minus office fee prior to closing date. Waitlist Entries: full refund if not accepted.

**Dogs:** Dogs must be leashed at all times while on the show grounds.

**Schooling:** You may school horses starting at 12pm (noon) on Friday afternoon anywhere in the Dressage complex including warmup and competition rings #1, #2, and #3. We will close Ring #1 for the Ride-a-Test Clinic Friday afternoon from approximately 3:30pm to 8:00pm. The Dressage Complex is also open on Sunday for anyone who'd like to stay over for additional schooling.

**Thoroughbred Incentive Program (T.I.P.):** High-point and high-score thoroughbred awards will be presented at the show. To be eligible for these awards a T.I.P. number must be provided by the day of the show. Riders of thoroughbreds can get a T.I.P. number at <https://tjctip.com/APPLYTIPNUMBER>

**Friday Afternoon - Ride-a-Test Clinic:** Join us Friday afternoon for a unique schooling opportunity to Ride-a-Test with Ken Levy "r" IN. If you are new to showing or would like some feedback from a USEF recorded judge prior to the show, you can enter class #001 "15 minute Ride-a-Test with Ken Levy "r" (Friday 4pm-8pm)" for \$20. Indicate the test you'd like to ride on your entry, and Ken will judge your ride then provide you some quick feedback to improve your performance.

The Ride-a-Test clinic opportunity is not part of the show, but rather a schooling event to get you better prepared for the actual show on Saturday. No awards will be given, and these scores will not be eligible for the Year End Awards program. The Ride-a-Test clinic will sell out after 16 entries.

**Classes:** Current USDF/USEF/FEI/WDAA tests will be used. Classes will be run in 20m x 60m rings unless stated otherwise. The show will be conducted under USEF rules unless otherwise noted by show management. Show management reserves the right to limit entries, limit the classes per horse, to add, divide, combine or cancel classes or make whatever changes required by circumstances of the competition.
