Awards: Ribbons awarded to 6th place in each class/division.

On-line Entries via Equestrian Hub at <https://equestrian-hub.com/> are preferred. **Mail Entries:** Entry form and Coggins should be mailed to show secretary with check payable to *Indiana Dressage Society*.

Coggins: Negative Coggins required for all horses within 12 months of show date. Name on Coggins must match the name of the horse on the entry form.

Complete entries must be received by the closing date. Each entry must be signed by the rider, owner of horse, trainer, and parent/guardian if under 18. Entries will be accepted in the order received until the show is full, then entries are added to the waitlist. Failure to submit a complete entry may result in being placed on the waitlist. IDS Members will have priority on the waitlist.

Ride Times: *Provisional* ride times will be posted to <https://equestrian-hub.com/> at least three days prior to show date. Ride times may change until 5pm the night before the show when they will be *Confirmed*.

Concessions: A food truck will be parked near Barn N, Stall 1 and offering delicious breakfast and lunch offerings Saturday and Sunday. **The first 30 correct and complete entries will receive a \$10 IDS Food Truck voucher!**

Attire: Formal show attire is optional in all classes. *USEF DR120* compliant protective headgear (helmet) with correctly fastened chinstrap must be worn by all riders at all times while mounted.

Schooling: You may school horses starting at 12pm (noon) on Friday anywhere in the Dressage Complex including warmup and competition rings #1, #2, and #3.

Non-Compete Horses: Non-compete horses must have a complete entry, valid Coggins, and pay Office Fee, Non-Compete Fee, plus either Stabling or Haul-in Fee.

Camping: Campsites include 30A electric and water may be reserved on the entry form.

Dogs: Dogs must be leashed at all times while on the show grounds.

Thoroughbred Incentive Program (T.I.P.): High-point and high-score thoroughbred awards will be presented at the show. To be eligible for these awards a T.I.P. number must be provided by the day of the show. Riders of thoroughbreds can get a T.I.P. number at <https://tjctip.com/APPLYTIPNUMBER>

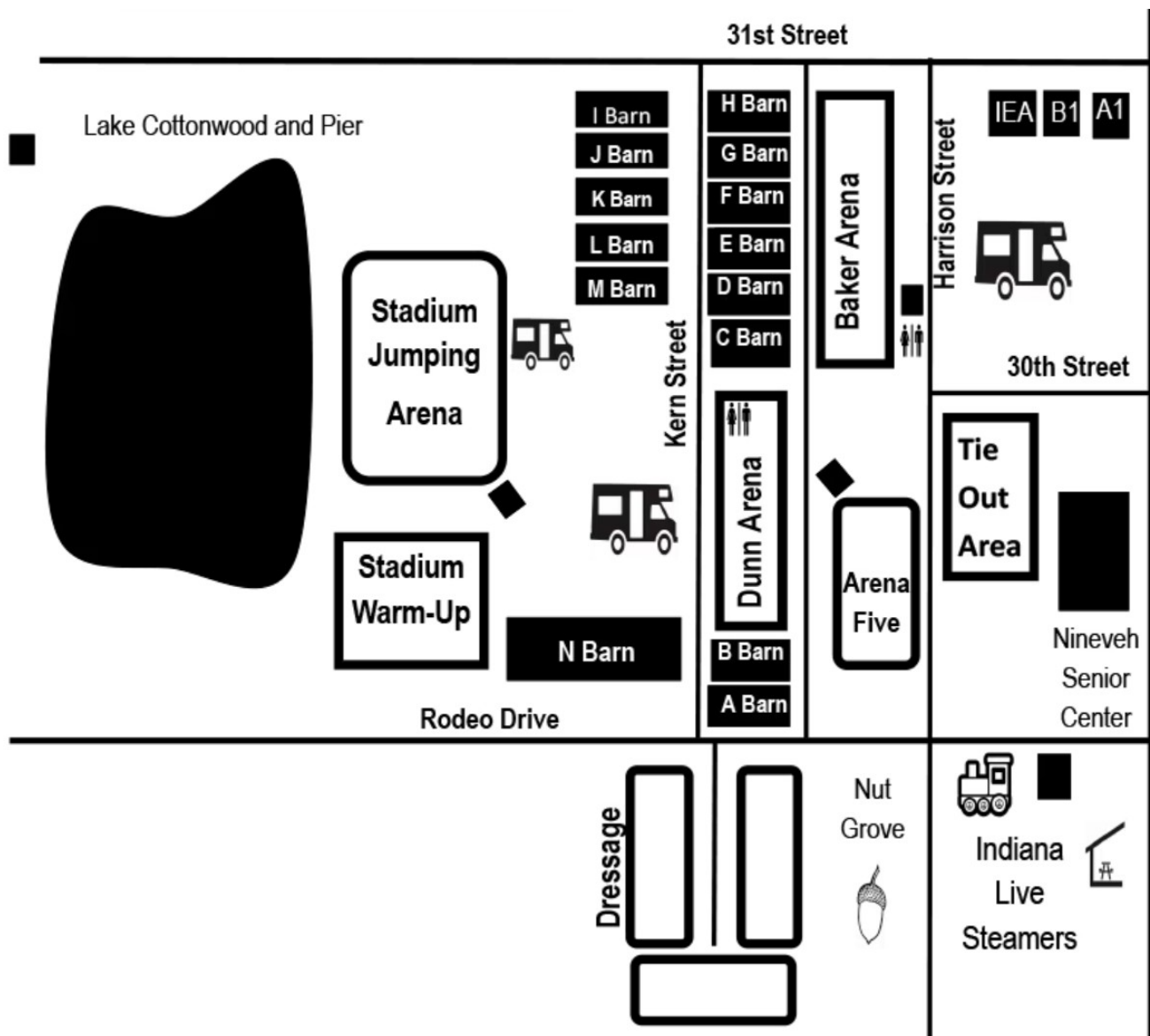

Refunds: Full refund minus office fee prior to closing date. Waitlist Entries: full refund if not accepted. No refunds for cancellations due to weather conditions or acts of God.

Bedding: Bedding can be ordered with your entry for \$10/bag. Bags will be in your stall when you arrive.

Stall Stripping: The Hoosier Horse Park requires you to strip your horse's stall and pile used bedding 1' outside the stall door upon departure. You may pay **the optional \$35 stall stripping fee** if you'd like to have your stall stripped by IDS after the show.

Classes: Current USDF/USEF/FEI/WDAA tests will be used. Classes will be run in 20m x 60m rings unless stated otherwise in the prizelist and/or official schedule. The show will be conducted under USEF rules unless otherwise noted by show management. Show management reserves the right to limit entries, limit the classes per horse, to add, divide, combine or cancel classes or make whatever changes required by circumstances of the competition.

Coached Test of Choice: Riders wishing for extra guidance from their coach during a judged ride can choose class #133 Coached Test of Choice. Plan to wear earbuds for your coach to communicate with you through an audio device of your choice. Scores from these classes do not count toward end of year awards and the classes will not be ribboned. Plan on early morning ride times for these classes.
