A few reminders:

- Competitors can arrive Friday after 10am.
- Office hours: 10am-8pm Friday, 8am-5pm on Saturday and Sunday.
- The official schedule will be posted outside of the Dressage Office.
- Schooling in the show rings and warm-up rings will end at 8pm daily.
- All horses must wear their numbers whenever out of their stalls.
- Lunging is allowed only in the delineated north 20m of warmup.

Musical Freestyle Competitors: Sound checks for the musical freestyles will run Friday night from 5:00-6:00pm. Please email your musical freestyle music as MP3 files to [mike@mikedawson.com](mailto:mike@mikedawson.com) or our show announcer Eric Sampson at [esampson4@comcast.net](mailto:esampson4@comcast.net). CDs can be dropped off at the show office during your sound check. If you need an alternate sound check time, contact Mike or Eric.

**OUT-OF-STATE HORSES:** In addition to a negative Coggins test (dated within one year of horse show date), all equines entering the state of Indiana from out-of-state must have a current health certificate while traveling.

**REMINDER USEF VACCINATION RULE (GR845):** Beginning December 1, 2015, all horses entering the grounds of a Federation- licensed competition must be accompanied by documentation of Equine Influenza Virus and Equine Herpes Virus (Rhinopneumonitis) vaccinations within six months prior to entering the stables. Intended to promote proper vaccination protocols, this rule does not anticipate an increased workload for competition management. The flu vaccination information can be added to the documentation already required by most competitions: a horse's health certificate and a negative Coggins test. You can also use the USEF Equine Vaccinations Record.

REMINDER - USEF SAFESPORT RULE (GR1303): Beginning January 1, 2019, all USEF members 18 and over with an Adult Competing Membership must complete Safe Sport training in order to be eligible to participate in USEF activities, including competitions.

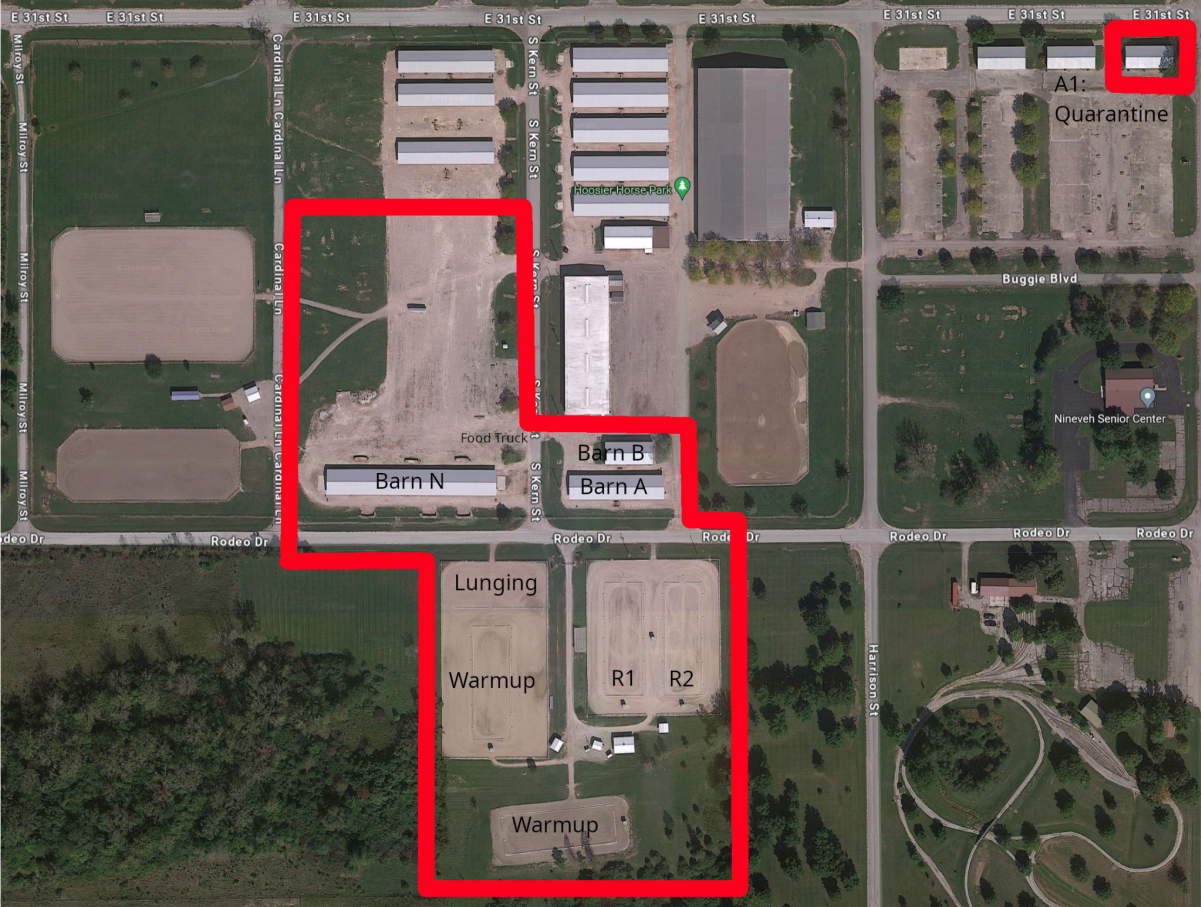

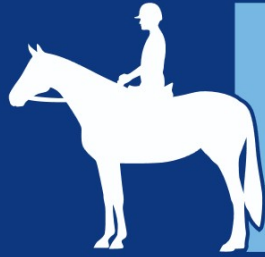
